Our “Flood Disaster Victims Support Office” is conducting a donation campaign. Many people are responding generously. From the support money, we are planning to provide economic assistance to those who meet the following conditions (1) and (2).

- (1) Catholics (Japanese or Foreigners) members of the parishes of the affected areas of Kumamoto, Fukuoka, and Saga prefectures whose houses (or condominiums where they are residing) have been damaged by the flood and have received a RISAI SHOMEI “disaster certificate”.
- (2) Those (including non-Catholics) who have been recognized by the parish authorities as persons in need of assistance.
 - ✓ Those whose workplace has been damaged by the flood and have seen their income affected by it.
 - ✓ GINOJISSEI (Technical interns)

- ✓ Economic assistance application form (the signature of the parish priest is needed)
- ✓ A copy of the RISAI SHOMEI “disaster certificate” (if applicable)
- ✓ Dome photos showing the damage (if applicable)
